

# The Liberals' secret plan to bring back WorkChoices.



Tony Abbott says WorkChoices is dead. But he refuses to release details of his industrial relations plans.

At the same time, Premier Colin Barnett is refusing to release a secret review of Western Australia's industrial relations laws. The review was undertaken by a lawyer who formerly worked for John Howard and Tony Abbott – a bad sign for workers. The last time the Liberals changed the state's IR laws, they brought in a local version of WorkChoices.

- Thousands of WA workers lost weekend penalty rates and overtime pay.
- 50% of individual contracts cut out annual leave.
- 56% of contracts paid below the award.
- 75% of contracts had no pay rise.

Over 300,000 West Australian workers are in danger of having their rights stripped away. Both Tony Abbott and Colin Barnett must come clean on their secret plans to bring back WorkChoices in Western Australia.
