A new programme of post-graduate studies at Monash University

You have the opportunity to pursue a cross-disciplinary post-graduate degree on work and labour issues, combining coursework and research flexibly for a Certificate, Diploma or Masters which may lead on to a doctorate.

You may study full-time or part-time, and work on a wide range of issues and topics, placing work and trade unionism in the context of the volatile global political economy.

You will be formally enrolled in the School of Political and Social Inquiry, under the auspices of W.A.G.E., Monash's Research Centre on Work and society in the Global Era. Dr. Carla Lipsig-Mummé, Research Professor of Political and Social Inquiry, directs this new programme.

Your degree will be in either Australian Studies, Politics or Sociology. You can combine labour-focused units with a wide range of units in these disciplines.

Through W.A.G.E. and Professor Lipsig-Mummé, you will also have the opportunity to participate in Working Groups on international work, labour and social advocacy topics, with academics and community/industrial relations practitioners. Involvement with the Research Committee on Global Labour of the International Sociology Association is also open to you.

Entry is flexible, and prior professional experience is considered in applications. Community and trade union experience welcome.
